ANNOUNCEMENT OF GRANT

Administered by the Colorado REALTORS® for Education, a 501(c)(3) non-profit Colorado corporation, the Grant Program provides grants to selected teachers, schools and districts in Colorado who need financial assistance to purchase and replace supplies, materials, equipment and other resources used to teach students in and out of the classroom. All grants must be used for materials and resources in the classroom or in connection with instruction given by a teacher to a class outside of the classroom.

Grants shall be considered and may be awarded in the following tiers which are listed in preferential order

Tier One: Pre-kindergarten through 5th Grade

Tier Two: 6th Grade through 8th Grade

Tier Three: 9th Grade through 12th Grade

General Guidelines:

Grants are intended to assist teachers, schools and school districts in Colorado. A grant provides REALTORS® an opportunity to support teachers, schools and school districts, and enhances the learning experience for students by providing classroom supplies, materials, equipment and other resources. A recipient, who receives a grant for 2007, must use the funds to purchase resources for the class in accordance with the Grant Application, no later 12 months from the date of the grant check.

Application:

Applications must be sent electronically or postmarked between January 10, 2007 and February 28, 2007. ("Open Application Period".) Submit a copy of the Application and supporting materials. Announcement of grant recipients will be made within sixty (60) days after Open Application Period ends.
